C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force included but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions). Only these athletes who comply with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022.

C.1 Additional IF Requirements:

C.1.1 Qualification Criteria OWG

To gain the right to participate in Olympic Winter Games (OWG) events, an athlete must have 180 IBU qualifying points or less as of 16 January 2022 (after the World Cup 5 in Ruhpolding/GER) or fulfil one of the following criteria during the current (2021/2022) or previous (2020/2021) season:

- Compete in two (2) competitions earning 150 IBU qualifying points or less at the IBU Cup, Open European Championships (OECH), World Championships (WCH) and/or World Cup (WC) in the Sprint or Individual events, or
- Two (2) finishes in the top half of the Junior World Championships (JWCH) - not Youth - or
- One (1) result from each of the criteria a. and b. above.

IBU Qualifying Points List (ref: IBU Event & Competition Rules Art. 1.4.3.4 & 1.4.3.5 http://res.cloudinary.com/deltatre-spa-ibu/image/upload/rdartycf3i2pnqx1fitg.pdf) Only NOCs which have not been allocated quota places through D.1, D.2 or D.3 will be eligible to be allocated up to a maximum of (2) quota places. The NOCs of the top ranked athletes from the respective gender's IBU qualifying points list as of 16 January 2022 (after WC 5 in Ruhpolding/GER) will earn quota places for their respective NOCs up to a maximum of two (2) quota places per NOC.

Affiliation of two (2) or more IBU National Federations to the same NOC

In the case where two (2) or more IBU National Federations are affiliated to the same NOC the following rules for quota allocation will apply:

For 2020/2021 IBU Final World Cup Nations Cup ranking purposes only the highest ranked National Federation will be taken into consideration for the allocation of quotas to the affiliated NOC for D.1, D.2 or D.3.

For IBU Qualifying Points List ranking purposes, the top athletes from the affiliated National Federations of the NOC will be taken into consideration for the allocation of quotas to the corresponding NOC for D.4.

If the NOC which is affiliated to two (2) or more National Federations earns quotas in D.1, D.2, D.3 or D.4, the selection of the athletes occupying the quotas are at the discretion of the NOC and the selected athletes will participate at the Olympic Winter Games as part of that NOC's delegation.

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Individual Competitions

If the Host Country has not been allocated any quota places through D.1, D.2, D.3 or D.4 or has only been allocated one (1) quota place through D.4 and it has eligible athletes according to Section C, it will receive up to a maximum of two (2) quota places per gender issued through D.4 to start in individual competitions. In such cases, up to a maximum of two (2) quota places will be deducted from the overall quota of 12 allocated in D.4.

Mixed Relay Competition

The Host Country is eligible to start in the Mixed Relay Competition provided they have sufficient athletes meeting the Athlete Eligibility requirements listed in C above.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

Following each qualification event, IBU will publish the results on its website <http://biathlonresults.com>.

The final World Cup Nations Cup Ranking List will be published on 21 March 2021.

For all NOCs earning quotas through the D.1, D.2, or D.3 above, IBU will inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places by 4 April 2021. The NOCs will then have until 18 April 2021 to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph **G. Qualification Timeline**.

The final IBU qualifying points list will be published on 16 January 2022 after the World Cup 5 in Ruhpolding, Germany.

For all NOCs earning quotas through the D.4 above, IBU will inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota place(s) on 17 January 2022. The NOCs will then have until 19 January 2022 to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph **G. Qualification Timeline**.

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED NOC QUOTA PLACES

IBU will inform the respective NOCs of their reallocated quota place(s) on 20 January 2022.

If any allocated quota place(s) is/are not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline on 21 January 2022 or is/are declined by the NOC, the quota place(s) will be reallocated to the NOC of the next highest ranked athlete according to D.4. The quota place may be reallocated to NOCs that have earned only one (1) quota in that gender or to a NOC that does not yet have a quota.
